

### About this book:

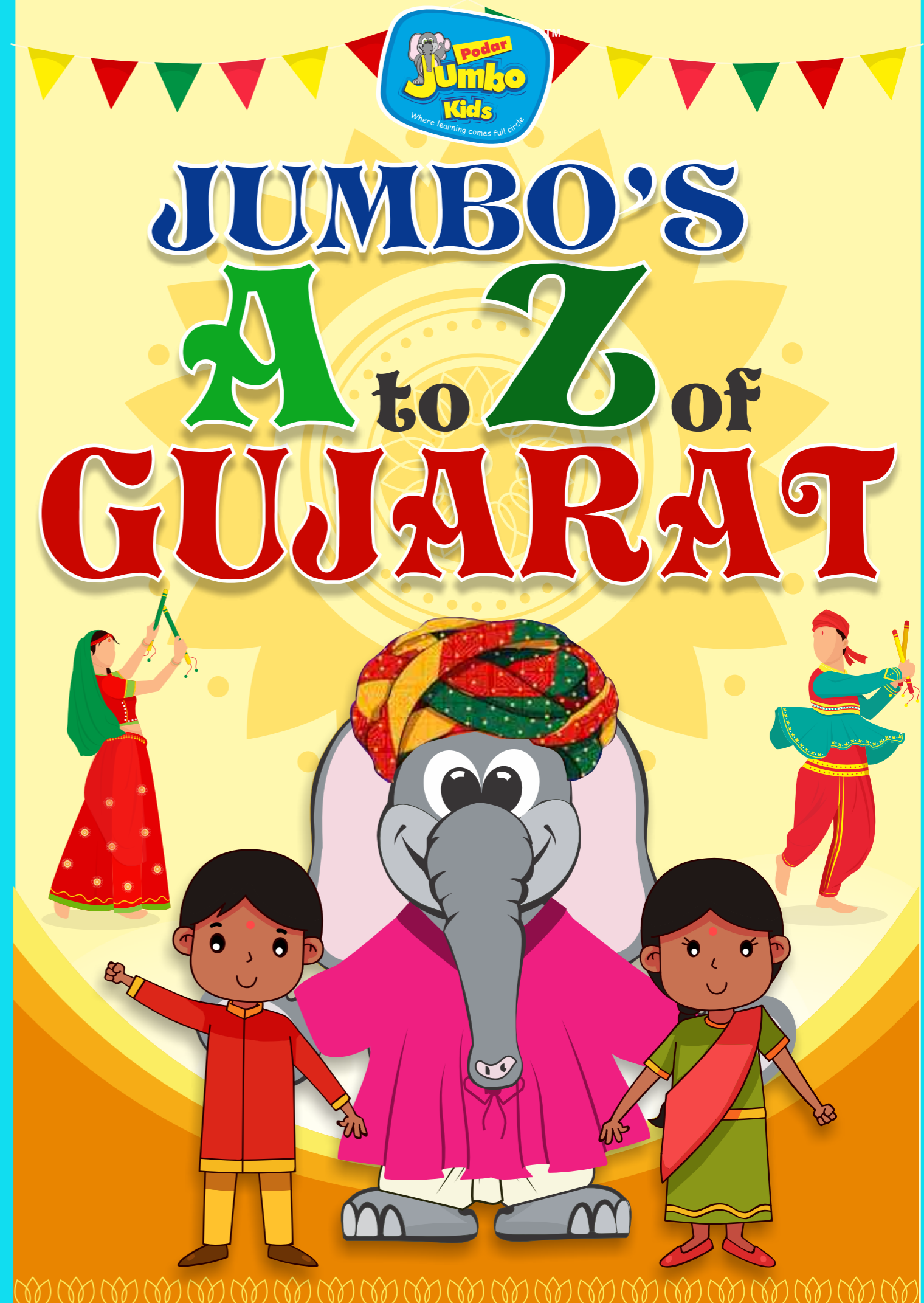
