

THE 9 INTELLIGENCES AT KIDUCATION



Our lesson planning shows that children have opportunities to use all the intelligences, although they will demonstrate varying levels of abilities. We use the checklist given below to develop opportunities for the widest range of abilities in addition to the formal skills of the traditional R's (Reading, writing, number work)

THE NINE INTELLIGENCES

Linguistic Intelligences

Can speak or write well, learns well from reading, writing, listening, researching.

Logical - Mathematical Intelligences

Able to reason, calculate, keep logic going, precise, likes mental problems,

Visual - Spatial Intelligences

Able to draw, copy, paint, work with images, observant, colour sensitive, good estimator.

Bodily - Kinaesthetic Intelligences

Able to use hands well, good at physical activity, good dancer, actor, mimic.

Musical Intelligences

Able to sing, play and compose music. Able to appreciate and hear different parts, make up songs, raps, rhythms, chants, keeps rhythm.

Interpersonal Intelligences

Relates well to others, works well in teams, help others, can manipulate others, popular, sensitive to others reactions.

Intrapersonal Intelligences

Thinks a lot, aware of self, can sum up situations clearly, self-motivated, often different, honest with self

Naturalist Intelligences

Interested in the environment and the living world, how nature develops and how the world works.

Spiritual Intelligences

Asks 'Big' questions about the purpose and beginning of things, sensitive to fairness and justice.
